In a prime position at Pavilion 4, just inside the main gates on Milton Street, the Sugar Industry Exhibition will focus on creating community awareness and interest in the rich history and importance of Mackay's sugar industry.

Showcasing a range of interactive displays from local companies that have a direct involvement with sugar production and processing, the exhibition aims to engage and inspire the next generation in securing the future of Mackay's sugar industry.

Please note that this is a COVID-19 safe event with Show regulations in place for the pavilion.

The Sugar Cane Subcommittee and the Mackay Show Association are excited to be back this year to bring people of our region together for the 142<sup>nd</sup> Show. Our new Sugar Industry Trade Exhibition will be a compelling reason for cane growers to spend more time at the Show this year, so please spread the word. See you there!



#### RULES (T&Cs)

- 1. All cane varieties must appear on the current Approved Varieties List for all Central District Mills.
- 2. All exhibits must be annual plant cane unless specified in the schedule (current season).
- 3. The Judges' decision will be final.
- 4. The growers' names must be displayed ONLY after the completion of judging.
- 5. All entries must be properly presented and stripped, NOT polished (see page 5).
- 6. Stick entries must be cut level with the ground, with NO roots.
- 7. Tops must be left on.
- 8. Sacking around stools for presentation is recommended.

All cane for exhibition may be entered at the cane exhibit area up to <u>6.00 pm</u> on Monday 13 June prior to the opening of the show (Tuesday 9 am). The cane drop off point is at Sugar Court located just inside the Milton Street gates, on the left, at Pavilion 4 (P4).

- 9. In CLASS 28004 (CCS) only Ratoon cane is eligible for entry (bundle of 2 & 4)
- 10. In CLASS 28004 (CCS) entries must be at least 1.5 metres in length (bundle of 2 & 4)
- 11. The Judge may withhold first place where he/she considers that entries are not worthy of the award.
- 12. In all classes where a monetary prize is listed, this will be presented by cheque (except for the children's class).
- 13. The Show Cane Committee reserves the right to reject unsuitable exhibits. The final arbiter is the Chief Steward.
- 14. Cane entries must have all the required details on the ticket accompanying their entries. This includes NAME, PHONE NUMBER, EMAIL (where you have an email), CLASS, VARIETY and school nominated (see following page).



#### PRESENTATION OF ENTRIES

All entrants are reminded that presentation is a part of the judging criteria which judges use when selecting the winning sugarcane.

Please note this presentation takes into account damage caused by seasonal weather or events.

The sugarcane entry should be:

- 1. Clean and stripped (but not polished)
- 2. No roots
- 3. Neat and tidy
- 4. Tops left on
- 5. Cut neatly.

#### THE IMPORTANCE OF TICKET DETAILS

Entrants are reminded that filling in the relevant information on the tickets provided to accompany entries provides the Chief Steward and judges with all the required information to host an equitable and efficient competition.

Your entry ticket will need to be completed with:

- 1. Your full name
- 2. Your email address (if you have one)
- 3. Your phone number
- 4. Class you are entering
- 5. The variety/varieties of your entry
- 6. And your nominated school (for points accrual to benefit our regional schools in the school's competition).
